Tier II Training & River Monitoring Projects Volunteers Needed - Limited Spots Available

Utah Water Watch and River Restoration have partnered to offer Tier II water quality monitoring trainings for ongoing river monitoring projects.

October 30: 9–11:30AM on the Jordan River and 1–3:30PM on the Weber River* Volunteers need to attend only one training session at the river they want to monitor. *Weather dependent - November 6 is reserved as a backup date.

Volunteers who participate will:

- Collect important water quality data on the Weber and/or Jordan Rivers
- Monitor the effectiveness of restoration projects on these rivers
- Monitor once a month for 9 months of the year (chemical and physical)
- Complete more intensive monitoring once a year (includes biological)





Who can participate:

- UWW volunteers who have participated in the Tier 1 program for at least one year
- Citizens who have some experience with environmental monitoring
- Citizens and Tier I volunteers looking to assist in data collection to fully participate in the project next year
